HAZARDS

FIRE	Ignites spontaneously on contact with air, generating intense heat and dense fumes. May re-ignite after fire is extinguished. Reacts violently with water. May react explosively with water. Runoff may create multiple fire or explosion hazard.
HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT	Contact with liquid causes severe burns. Inhalation or contact with fumes may cause severe injury or death. Symptoms may be delayed. Risk of serious damage to eyes. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may pollute waterways.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

EMERGENCY RESPONDERS	Wear SCBA and chemical splash suit when handling these substances. If available, special aluminized protective clothing with remote air supply is preferable. Structural firefighter's uniform will only provide limited protection.
