EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

If This Happens ↓	Do This ↓
For All Emergencies	Shut off engine and any electrical equipment and leave 'off'. No smoking, naked lights or other sources of ignition in the immediate vicinity. Evacuate the immediate area; keep upwind. Check for spills or leaks. Send message to police and fire brigade. Tell them the location, material, UN Number, quantity and emergency contact as well as condition of vehicle and damage observed. Warn other traffic.
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Carry out action under 'For All Emergencies'. Avoid moving vehicle if movement could cause or increase spillage.
