HAZARDS

Fire	Will not burn but will increase the intensity of a fire. May react with hydrocarbons (fuels) to form a Class 1.1 explosive. In this condition it should be handled as an explosive. May explode from heating, or detonation, especially if contaminated or confined. Fire may produce irritating, poisonous and/or corrosive gases. Rigid containers may explode when strongly heated. FIBCs will melt and not contain pressure under similar conditions. Runoff may create fire hazard.
Health	When exposed to fierce heat, toxic gaseous oxides of nitrogen are given off. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may pollute waterways.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING*

Emergency responders	In absence of fire, wear overalls, safety glasses and protective gloves. In presence of fire, wear SCBA and chemical splash suit. Structural firefighter's uniform will provide limited protection.
