PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Standards Australia Committee MN-007, Refractories and Refractory Materials, to supersede AS 1774.4.4—1992. In preparing this Standard, reference was made to ASTM C1054-85, *Pressing and drying refractory plastic and ramming mix specimens*.

METHOD

1 SCOPE

This Standard describes procedures for laboratory preparation of test pieces from mouldable refractories.

The Standard does not apply to mouldable refractories that are supplied dry.

3 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Standard, the definitions given in AS 2780 apply.

4 PRINCIPLE

Mouldable material is consolidated in a mould, and allowed to dry under specified conditions.
