PREFACE

METHOD

1 SCOPE

This Standard sets out a method for measuring the adhesion of decorative paper foils to wood-based panel substrates. It is applicable to reconstituted wood-based panels overlaid with a decorative paper foil.

3 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Standard, the definitions in AS/NZS 4491 and AS/NZS 4266.1 apply.

4 PRINCIPLE

The quality of adhesion is determined by counting the number of pieces with paper foils removed.
