HAZARDS

FIRE	<p>May be ignited by heat, sparks or flame. Vapours, dusts, borings or turnings may form explosive mixtures with air. Fire may produce irritating and toxic vapours. May burn fiercely. May re-ignite after fire is extinguished. Containers may explode when heated. Some substances are transported in molten form. Solids may melt and flow when heated or involved in a fire.</p>
HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT	<p>May be poisonous if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Contact with molten substance may cause severe burns. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may pollute waterways.</p>

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

EMERGENCY RESPONDERS	<p>Wear SCBA and chemical splash suit. Structural firefighters' uniform may provide limited protection.</p>
