PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee TM-003, Timber Grading, to supersede AS 1613—1997. After consultation with stakeholders in both countries, Standards Australia and Standards New Zealand decided to develop this Standard as an Australian Standard rather than an Australian/New Zealand Standard.

This revision is basically a re-confirmation of the 1997 edition.

The publication of the range of standard colours and the associated F-grades of timber is not to be interpreted as a direction to colour mark all F-graded timber.

The colours listed are referenced to colours specified in AS 2700, *Colour Standards for general purposes*, which applies to pigmented paints. The colour specification given in Table 1 can be regarded only as a general guide to the intended colours.
